Principles of Operation

The goal of afternoon activities is to offer children safe extra-curricular activities that support the growth of a child. Activities are in keeping with primary school laws and are guided by principles set forth by the National Board of Education and guidelines set by the afternoon activities programme in the town.

The daily programme encompasses supervised outdoor activities, exercise, games, crafts, doing homework and rest. Afternoon activities assures that a child is not alone without the presence of a trusted adult and guides a child to an active, healthy lasting lifestyle.

Target Group

Afternoon activities is meant for 1st and 2nd graders, as well as pupils in grades 1 –9 who have a decree designating a need for special support.

Arrangements

Afternoon activities is available from 12 pm to 5 pm every school day of the year, with the exception of the last day of the spring term. Care is provided either at school or within close proximity of the school. A snack is available to children as part of after-school care. The adult leaders are professional child and youth workers.

Fees

At the moment the cost of afternoon activities is 80 €/month. The fee can be reduced if the child is absent 10 schooldays or more in a month. If the child is absent for the whole month due to a sickness, the fee will not be collected (doctor's certificate needed). The fee may be waived also in certain social cases. How to Apply

The period for application to the afternoon activities programme for the 2023- 2024 school year is 10.1.—28.2.2023. Applications should be made online .

First grade applications are given preference. Remaining places will be filled with as many second graders as are places available. In the event that there are more applicants than places, a lottery will determine placing. Those without a place will be put on a waiting list. It is possible to apply for vacancies at a later date.

Those in special education schools can also apply on the day that pupils visit school in the spring.

Paper applications for afternoon activities are also available at the Pori Department of Education as well as from ILTIS groups.

Terminating Afternoon activities

Should a parent wish to entirely relinquish an after-school care place, a written letter of termination to the Department of Education is required one month in advance (e-mail to iltis@pori.fi). Payment will not be required beginning the month of termination and thereafter.
