	The register is based on Museum Act (314/2019), Section 18 of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999) on good information management practices and the Archive Act (831/1994) and the provisions and regulations issued pursuant thereto.

14. Other Rights Related to the	The data subject has the right to request restriction of processing if:
Processing of Personal Data	a) the accuracy of the personal data is contested, allowing time for the data controller to verify its accuracy;
	b) the processing is unlawful, and the data subject opposes erasure, requesting restriction instead;
	c) the data controller no longer needs the personal data for processing purposes, but the data subject requires them for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims;
	d) the data subject has objected to the processing pending the verification of whether the data controller's legitimate grounds override those of the data subject.
	To the extent that the processing of personal data is based on the data subject's consent, the data subject has the right to withdraw consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
15. Right to Lodge a Complaint	The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority about the processing of personal data.
