Children won't be bored in Pori. The city offers many kinds of activities for children, starting from the long-standing favourites of Yyteri and Kirjurinluoto and also including art and other attractions. Check out these tips for a successful family holiday!



## OPEN-AIR SWIMMING POOL 1

Metsämiehenkatu 8

The open-air swimming pool has been a summer favourite among locals since 1957. You can also swim during winter, from autumn to spring, in 3–5 degree water in the children's pool, for an experience akin to ice swimming.

## PUBLIC INDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

Keskustan uimahalli, Presidentinpuistokatu 6 2

Meri-Porin uimahalli, Mustalammentie 8 3

There are two public indoor swimming pools in Pori: one in the city centre and one at Meri-Pori. At the city centre indoor swimming pool, you can splash around in several pools and descend the thrilling water slide. For lovers of warmth, there is also a heated pool. The indoor swimming pools are open to the public from autumn to spring.

## REPOSAARI FORTRESS 4

Junnilla camping centre, Kaivokatu 18

This seaside fortress was originally built in the 1930s as a coastal defence system. Today, it is open to the public all year round!

Kirjurinluoto Park, known among the locals as *Kirvatsi* or *Kirjuri*, is the central park in Pori and part of Finland's national network of urban parks. Accessible completely free of charge, Kirjurinluoto is an all-year-round recreational area for children and adults, situated only a five-minute walk from Pori's market square. This is a green oasis, center of events and, in our opinion, the best play area in all of Finland – find your favourite adventure: A day in Kirjurinluoto is a day packed with fun!



## PELLE HERMANNI PARK

15

The famous Pelle Hermanni park in Kirjurinluoto is almost the size of five football pitches put together. The park features a wide range of play areas, slides and climbing frames suitable for all ages – all without an entrance fee! The service building adjacent to the play area is open from spring to autumn and includes a baby changing room, social facilities and a café. At Pelle Hermanni park is the accessible music playpark Virtuosi, which has many different kinds of instruments and activating toys, as well as the accessible play ship Kuunari Tähti (Schooner Star).

## CHILDREN'S TRAFFIC PARK VINKKARI

16

The children's traffic park provides safe and educational experiences of traffic – and it's great fun! Pedal cars and bikes are available in the park. Vinkkari is open in summer. Admission is free and the traffic park is suitable for ages 4 to 10.

## ENERGIAKENTTÄ

17

Situated next to the traffic park, Energiakenttä offers families opportunities for sports and play. There's a climbing frame for children and Street Workout equipment for adults.

## ANIMALS

18

Alpacas, goats, chickens, roosters, ducks, peacocks and many other animals are waiting to see you at Kirjurinluoto every summer.



## BEACH

19

The shallow, sandy beach of Kirjurinluoto is perfect for swimming and playing right in the heart of the city. Kirjurinluoto beach is ideal for having a picnic, playing beach volleyball or table tennis in the area reserved for sports and games, and of course basking in the sun.

## EXHIBITION GARDEN AND NATURE TRAILS

20

21 Kirjurinluoto is a large lush park with nature trails and beautiful exhibition gardens. The nine-hectare Hanhiluoto botanical garden features trees, shrubs and flowers that grow in the Satakunta region. From Hanhipuisto, you can walk along the bridge or take a hand-operated cable ferry to Polsanluoto island, where you'll find a nature trail with wild plants.

## A PARADISE FOR OUTDOOR ENTHUSIASTS

21

Magnificent jogging or hiking terrain, the peace of nature, birdsong on the river delta. Kirjurinluoto is a fantastic setting for outdoor life close to the city centre. You can also find a disc golf course and outdoor exercise equipment there.



## CENTRE FOR EVENTS

Over the decades, Kirjurinluoto has grown into a globally renowned events venue. Kirjurinluoto Arena, the Lökkilava stage, the roofed amphitheatre and the incredibly large park area attract around half a million visitors each year to a range of festivals, concerts, fairs, summer theatre and park exercise sessions.

## THE LOVE PARK

22

The Love Park is the best setting for Instagram pictures in Pori. Seal your love with a padlock, admire the beautiful city from the heart-shaped swing, or sit down for a relaxed picnic in this lovely park.

The Pori region treats nature lovers with an abundance of options. The unique Yyteri seaside area, the Bothnian Sea National Park, the largest river delta in the Nordics, without forgetting about the oases of nature within the city – there is something for everyone to enjoy. The diverse hiking and biking routes lead from duckboards to nature observation towers, from city streets to quiet islets, from peaty forests to sandy beaches.



## NATIONAL URBAN PARK

What would Pori be without Kirjurinluoto, Eteläranta, the old town centre of Kivi-Pori, or the outdoor recreation areas of Pori Forest? They are all part of Pori's National Urban Park, which is used for recreation and exercise by thousands of Pori residents every day.

## PORI FOREST 23

Part of the National Urban Park, the Pori Forest has trails for walking, running and biking in the summertime. In winter, some of the trails serve as cross-country skiing tracks. Those who want to take their exercise to the maximum can add the Masters' Steps workout stairs to their jog.

## PORI KARHU TRAIL 24

The Ahlainen, Noormarkku and Joutsijärvi hiking routes comprise a total 150 km of nature trails.

## BOTHNIAN SEA NATIONAL PARK

Stretching from Kustavi to Merikarvia, the Bothnian Sea National Park invites you to explore its waves and shores. If you're lucky, you might even see some grey seals or white-tailed eagles. The island destinations of Iso-Enskeri and Säppi, which is a lighthouse island, can also be visited by joining a boat trip organised during the summer season. For more information on boat trips, see [shop.visitpori.fi](https://shop.visitpori.fi). The Bothnian Sea National Park also extends to the mainland in Pori. You can explore the sea shore on trails including duckboards and nature observation towers.



## YYTERI BIRD BEACH - NATURE TRAILS 25

More than 30 km of hiking trails and 15 nature observation towers. Campfire sites can be found at the Yyteri Square and Munakarinsäikkä spit, where you can admire the sea landscape whilst preparing your lunch on the open fire.

## MERIKARVIANJOKI RIVER 26

Merikarvianjoki is one of the most popular fishing destinations in Southern Finland. The river's rapids provide great settings for fly and lure fishing. You can fish the entire Merikarvianjoki area with one fishing permit. Almost every rapids area is equipped with basic facilities such as a dry closet and campfire site with firewood. These facilities are freely available to fishers and hikers.

## OURALUOTO 27

Part of the municipality of Merikarvia, the Oura archipelago consists of numerous small and medium-sized protruding rocks and islets in the Bothnian Sea. Very different from other Finnish archipelagos, the landscape also features diverse nature. Ouraluoto is a maintained recreational area and part of the Bothnian Sea National Park. You can stay overnight on the islet in the historical buildings called Ryssänkäsarmi and Luotsiasema. There is also a sauna, which can be reserved by contacting the Merikarvia municipality.

## LAUHANVUORI-HÄMEENKANGAS UNESCO GLOBAL GEOPARK 28

The outdoor recreation area on the border between three provinces brings together the region's internationally significant geological heritage, valuable natural assets and local cultural features.

The sands of Yyteri beach invite you to enjoy life in a way that usually requires travelling thousands of kilometres. The greatest beach in the Nordic region is a one-of-a-kind destination that offers opportunities for fun in the sun around sand dunes that are protected under the Natura programme. It is also much more, as the Yyteri area also includes the Kallo and Reposaari islands and the Ahlainen district, as well as the picturesque scenery between them. With unique nature and excellent services, Yyteri offers something to enjoy all year round.



## THE BEACH

When it comes to Yyteri, the word 'paradise' is not an exaggeration. The child-friendly shallow water is irresistible to adults and children alike in the summer. How about the winter? Whereas in the summer you can swim and build a sand castle that rivals the Sagrada Familia, in the wintertime you can go sledging and build a snow castle or at least a snow man. The beach is the place to be regardless of the season!

## ADVENTURES

During the day, you can play in the play area by the beach, bounce on a trampoline or test your limits in the climbing park. Perhaps you'd like to surf the waves or try abseiling? In the Yyteri countryside, you can play golf, ride a fatbike or go jogging. On the fitness trail, you can do step training or visit an outdoor gym. There are many kilometres of trails with a wide range of scenery: sea, dunes, forests and marshland. Even dogs have their own beach at Mäntyluoto. There are no limits to adventure in Yyteri.



## LOVE THE LYME GRASS

Did you know that the shores and the entire area of Yyteri are preserved in line with the protection objectives of the Natura 2000 network? The protection measures ensure the conservation of the area's natural habitats and species. If not for the lyme grass catching the wind-blown sand, there would be no dunes. Therefore, in order to protect the vulnerable dune environment, all visitors in Yyteri should be careful not to harm the lyme grass and other flora in the area.



## BLUE FLAG – WHAT'S THAT?

Yyteri is the first Finnish destination that has been granted the Blue Flag certificate in the beach category. Blue Flag is one of the world's most recognised eco-labels awarded to beaches, marinas and sustainable boating tourism operators. Let Yyteri inspire you in a sustainable way!

## KALLO

When someone from Pori falls in love, they take their sweetheart to the island of Kallo in Mäntyluoto to admire the lighthouse and smooth sea-kissed rocks. When someone from Pori goes through a break-up, they go back to Kallo to watch the storm beat down on the same rocks. Next to Kallo is the Uniluoto neighbourhood, where you can sense both the calmness and the restlessness of the sea.

## REPOSAARI

Räfsö, Räpsöö, Reffzöö – the island is known by many names. It also has many experiences to offer to open-minded travellers. Charming wooden houses, restaurants, the church and the exciting fortress are only a few of its sights. Explore the thousand stories of this island by yourself or on a guided walking tour, which are available in the summer.

## SAARISTOTIE AND AHLAINEN

The Saaristotie route gives you the opportunity to leave the stress of daily life behind and rest your soul. Nature shows its beautiful face at its most pristine. Around Saaristotie, you can admire the sea and beautiful scenery. You'll also get to visit the idyllic village of Ahlainen, known for its charming scenery and authentic village path with wooden houses and huts by the shore.



Experience sightseeing in Pori, the architecture and the mausoleum. Plan your visit! Visit the lovely Ahlström Ironworks, including Villa Mairea. The famous Jusélius mausoleum, the old town centre of Kivi-Pori, the market square and the beautiful churches are only a few examples of the local sights.

### AHLSTRÖM IRONWORK 29

Laviantie 14

The Ahlström Ironwork in Noormarkku is one of Finland's largest and most magnificent ironworks areas. It includes a high-quality hotel and restaurant as well as cultural tours.

### ALVAR AALTO ATTRACTIONS

Villa Mairea in Noormarkku and Kauttuan Terasitalo are buildings in which everyday life merges with architecture, iconic design furniture, art and wellness. Guided tours "In the footsteps of Alvar Aalto" in Noormarkku introduce the collaboration between Ahlström and Aalto, which resulted in the creation of masterpieces that are still relevant today in the middle of pine forests. People come from all over the world to see these beautiful examples of design and art!

### JUSÉLIUS MAUSOLEUM 31

Maantiekatu 33

Jusélius Mausoleum is located at the Käppärä Cemetery, a few kilometres from the market square. It is one of Pori's most popular sights. The mausoleum was built for the local industrialist Fritz Arthur Jusélius as the final resting place for his daughter Sigrid, who died of tuberculosis at the age of 11.

### THE OLD TOWN CENTRE AND RIVER 32

Kivi-Pori is the "old town" of Pori, characterised by numerous beautiful old stone buildings. In the old town centre, you will find the Palace of Junnelius, which serves as the Town Hall of Pori, the Pori Old Town Hall completed in 1841 and its English-style Raatihuoneenpuisto park, as well as the elegant theatre building. The stone houses and public buildings in Pori's seaside Eteläranta district constitute one of the most impressive old stone neighbourhoods in Finland. This district is located between the riverside of Eteläranta and Valtakatu.

### CHURCHES

The churches in the Pori region are culturally and historically significant and represent varying architecture. Pori's oldest church is at Ahlainen and the largest one, representing the neo-Gothic style, is Keski-Pori Church in the city centre.

### LEINEPERI IRONWORK 33

Pitkäjärventie 7, Leineperi

This 19th-century ironworks milieu in Ulvila forms a peaceful cultural setting where you can hear the sounds of the nearby rapids while visiting artisans' workshops, exhibitions and the cafe-restaurant in a unique environment.

### VILLA MAIREA 29

Pikkukoivukuja 20

Alvar and Aino Aalto designed Villa Mairea as a home for their friends Maire and Harry Gullichsen. Located in the Noormarkku Ironworks area, the building was completed in 1939. At the time, Harry Gullichsen was the General Director of A. Ahlström Oy. Maire Gullichsen was a sponsor and collector of arts, and her collection of foreign art is on display in Villa Mairea. The building also accommodates the Maire Foundation established by Maire Gullichsen. The Foundation is responsible for showing the building to the public and taking care of its collections. Villa Mairea can be visited on guided tours. Visited by thousands of people every year, it is one of the most renowned private homes in the world.

Pori has several museums and art galleries for people who enjoy culture, history and modern art.



## THE ARK NATURE CENTRE 5

Pohjoispuisto 7

The basic exhibition at the Ark Nature Centre features the nature of Satakunta: the mouflons and other species found on the island of Säppi, as well as Finland's large predators. There is also plenty to see for bird and butterfly enthusiasts.

## SATAKUNTA MUSEUM 6 i

Hallituskatu 11

Satakunta Museum was awarded as the Museum of the Year 2019. The museum's three floors present a journey into life in Satakunta from the distant past to the present day. As of 1 March, the Museum will also be serving as a tourist information point.

## RENOVATION CENTRE TOIVO 7

Varvinkatu 19

An atmospheric courtyard surrounded by century-old log houses that are now home to the Satakunta Museum's Renovation Centre Toivo and the Korsman house. In the Korsman house, visitors can go back in time to see what the home of an ordinary family in Pori looked like in the 1950s.

## PORIGAL GALLERY 34

Eteläranta 6

Porigal Gallery is used by Pori Art Museum for temporary exhibitions, showcasing contemporary Finnish and regional art, without forgetting the international perspective. The gallery is located in a former salt warehouse building by river Kokemäenjoki. Admission to the gallery is free of charge.

## NAURAVA LOHIKÄÄRME - INFORMATION CENTRE OF PREHISTORY 35

Eurantie 18, Eura

The first information centre of prehistory in Finland showcases the prehistory of Eura, especially the rich Viking Age (800-1050 AD), in an experiential way. The exhibits include both original finds and copies. The copies can be touched! Visitors also have the opportunity to try out different examples of ancient technology.



## ROSENLEW MUSEUM 36

Kuninkaanlahdenkatu 14

In Aittaluoto, next to a traditional industrial area, you can familiarise yourself with the history and production of the Pori-based company Rosenlew (1953-1987). The changing exhibitions expand perspectives on different topics concerning industry and technology.

## PORI ART MUSEUM 37

Eteläranta

Founded in 1981, the Pori Art Museum is a museum of contemporary art known for its high-quality temporary exhibitions. The exhibitions feature contemporary phenomena in international and Finnish art and raise relevant questions. The Art Museum building will undergo a basic renovation in 2023-2024. The museum will be closed for public during the renovation and reopened in summer 2024.


